### TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WHICHFORD ROAD, STOURTON

Warwickshire County Council **has made** a Temporary Traffic Order details as indicated below:

<b>Effect of Order</b>	Whichford Road, Stourton closed to vehicular traffic from Cotswold Distillery to Brook House.
<b>Reason for Order</b>	To enable sewer connection works.
<b>Order Effective from:</b> 4 February 2026 for up to 18 months or until works are completed, whichever is sooner.	
<b>Anticipated Completion Date:</b> 12 February 2026	
<b>Access &amp; Diversion:</b> An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Whichford Road, Village Road, Church Row, The Close, Little Wolford Road, Wood Lane, Shipston Road, Main Street, Oxford Road, Rollright Road, road from District Boundary East to junction South of Hutton Grange, road from High Street North to District Boundary, Whichford Hill, Francis Leys Hill, Hook Norton Road, The Green, Barrats Hill and vice versa.  Vehicular access & egress will be maintained where possible
